I want to share with you some of the recent signposts of our success. I'm proud to say that we were again ranked first in the nation in National Institutes of Health (NIH) research grants awarded to pharmacy schools. We recruited several brilliant young faculty members this year, leading a colleague of mine to exclaim: “You have the brightest new hires on campus, Mary Anne!” Applications to the PharmD program rose from 854 in 2003 to 1,200 in 2004 despite another sharp hike in student fees.

As always, your support has been a critical ingredient in our continuing success. Annual Fund contributions, for example, gave us the means to renovate and move the Student Center and Student Affairs Office to the 9th floor at our Parnassus campus, giving students a place to gather, collaborate on group projects and sometimes simply lend one another moral support.

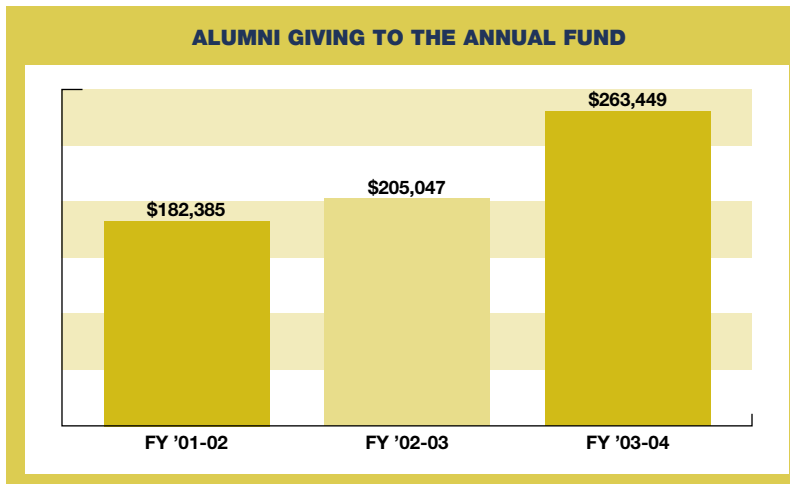

A Gift that Builds on Success

The dismal pharmacist-to-patient ratio in California's Central Valley is among the worst in the state. A new program from the UCSF School of Pharmacy seeks to change this startling statistic—and a generous gift from alumnus Vince Isnardi '43 is helping to make the change.

The UCSF-Fresno Pharmacy Education Program aims to meet the healthcare and pharmaceutical needs of the Central Valley's diverse population. Program leaders plan to achieve this goal by promoting health research in the area and introducing young people in underrepresented groups to pharmacy careers.

At the heart of the program are six-week clinical rotations for third- and fourth-year UCSF pharmacy students in local hospitals, clinics, community pharmacies and health maintenance organizations. "The program is receiving very positive feedback," says program director Mitra Assemi, PharmD. "All eight students scheduled to participate in the program next year ranked it as their first choice of sites—a definite vote of confidence."



The rotations are meant to encourage students to return to the Central Valley after graduation. Natalie Vieira, PharmD '04, exemplifies the results Assemi and her team hope to achieve. A Fresno area native and a UCSF student who returned to complete her rotations in Fresno, Natalie stayed on in the area, accepting a position at one of her student rotation sites. She will work for Model Health Care, an independent pharmaceutical consulting firm founded by Russ Zakarian, PharmD '76. The firm specializes in providing services to nursing homes and long-term care facilities, particularly in the underserved rural areas of the Central Valley.

A second key component of the program is an outreach effort intended to attract high school students. One such effort is the Doctor's Academy, a magnet program founded at Fresno's Sunnyside High School by the UCSF School of Medicine. The University designed the program to encourage and mentor students interested in the health professions. UCSF School of Pharmacy faculty created the pharmacy portion of the curriculum, which introduces students to careers in pharmacy and offers shadowing opportunities with pharmacists throughout the Central Valley. 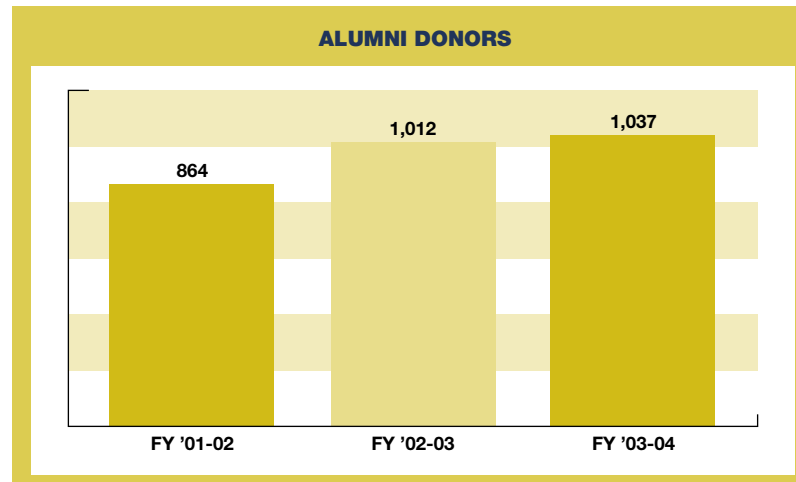

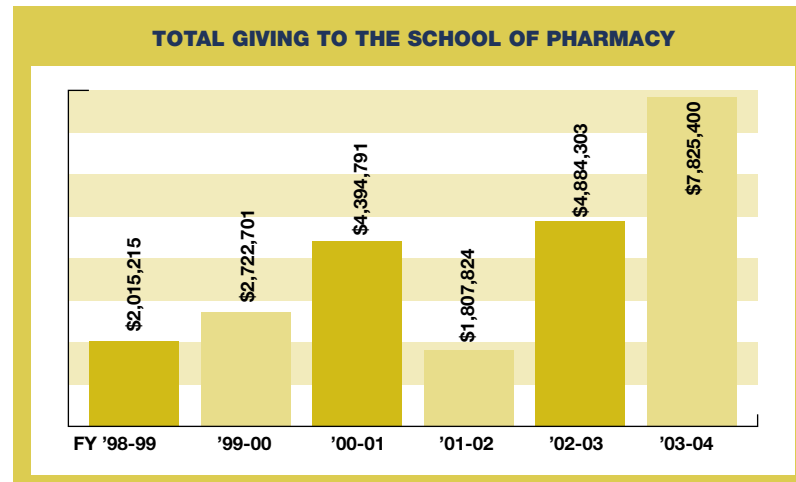

A Generous Expression of Trust

When Carl Lovotti '15 left a bequest in excess of \$5 million to the School of Pharmacy, he gave virtually no instructions on how it should be used. Instead, Carl allowed Dean Mary Anne Koda-Kimble to direct it to the School's most pressing needs.

"The exceptional size of the gift reflects how much Mr. Lovotti valued the School of Pharmacy, and I am grateful for the trust he has placed in us," Dean Koda-Kimble says. "At a time of diminishing budgets and rising costs, Mr. Lovotti's bequest will enable the School not only to maintain the quality of its programs, but to dream of even better ways to benefit the public, students and faculty. His gift simply could not have come at a better time."

Carl faithfully supported the School of Pharmacy Annual Fund for many years and established a living trust to outline the division of his estate. Born in San Francisco in 1894, Carl began his career at a successful Sutter Street pharmacy that he eventually purchased. He lived on Russian Hill for most of his life and loved to reminisce about the turn-of-the-century San Francisco of his youth.

Giving Back to Students and Science

After he served in the Navy Hospital Corps, a passion for medicine and health brought Hal Walton, BS '49, to UCSF, where he earned his degree in pharmacy. Hal worked in retail pharmacy for five years before a growing interest in the business of pharmacy led him to pursue an MBA degree.

For the next 35 years, he worked both in pharmaceutical manufacturing and in the advertising industry, focusing on pharmaceutical market and media research. He is the author of two papers: one that offers a mathematical model for successful media selection, and another that explores the connection between ad recognition and prescribing by physicians.

So when Hal and his wife, Rochelle, decided to make a gift to the School of Pharmacy, they wanted to make a contribution that would provide support for the increasingly important field of information management. Hal and Rochelle have thus made a provision in their estate to create a distinguished professorship for a faculty member who will specialize in this area of pharmaceutical research, and they have established several annuities that will eventually fund the professorship.

“This is a place worthy of support,” Hal says. For Rochelle, a musician whose passion is teaching, a gift to the School of Pharmacy offers an ideal way to give back—“to do some good for the kids and for science.”
