

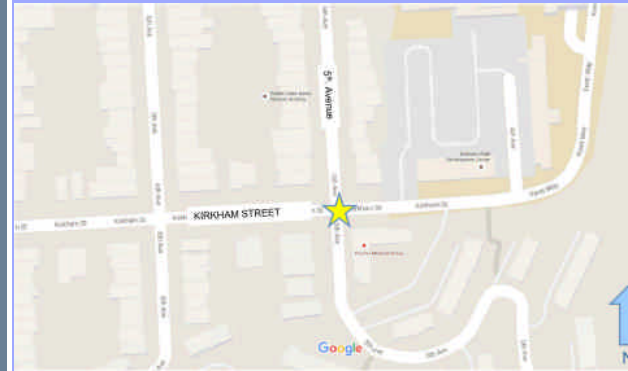

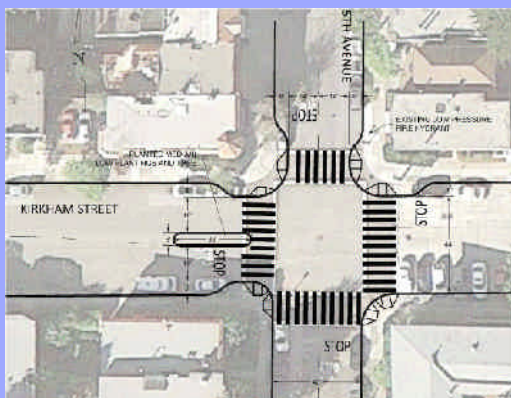
The project

History: Neighbors near the Parnassus Campus expressed concern about on-going traffic issues near the campus, especially along Fifth Avenue. UCSF held 2 community meetings on 8/29/2012 and 2/20/2013.

Goals: UCSF staff worked with the residents to develop conceptual plans for pedestrian safety and traffic-calming improvements for the Fifth Avenue & Kirkham Street intersection.

Key Elements:

- Bulb-outs
- Curb ramps
- Repaving
- Crossing improvements
- Median Island Landscaping
