

Shuttles

- A fleet of 80 shuttles service 18 locations and transport 2 million passengers per year.
- Network serves major locations: Parnassus Heights, Mission Bay, Dogpatch, Mt. Zion, Laurel Heights, Mission Center, SF Veterans Hospital and ZSFG.
- Transitioning to an all-electric fleet in October 2018, starting with fifteen 40-passenger buses.
- Removes 2,700 cars from road each year.

Parking

- 5,000 garage and 3,000 surface lot parking spaces for employee permit and patient/visitor public parking at all major campus locations.

Bicycling & “Scoot”

- Free bike registration with online bike safety quiz (8,500+ permit holders).
- 1,200 bike parking spaces currently available at various campus locations.
- Free access to bike cages (Parnassus, Mission Bay, Mt. Zion) with ID proximity card access & security cameras.
- Free tire repair kits with Bike Fix-It Stations available at Parnassus and Mission Bay Campuses.
- Bike shower program at Fitness Centers (\$17/month).
- Discount SF Bike coalition membership.
- Bike racks on all shuttles.
- Bay Area Bike Share stations at Mission Bay and MCB.
- Scoots (all-electric scooters) available at Mission Bay and Parnassus Heights with 10 scoot pods at each location.

Fuel Efficient Vehicles

- Total of 80 active E/V stations with more stations coming online in 2019.
- UCSF vehicle fleet includes 64 (of 223) low emitting alternative fuel and hybrid vehicles, including vehicles that run on CNG (Compressed Natural Gas), ethanol (E85) and fully electric vehicles.
- Preferred parking spaces available to public and UCSF permit holders who drive fuel-efficient vehicles.

Commute Planner

- mycommute.ucsf.edu portal for UCSF community to help plan their commutes.

Vehicle Sharing Programs

- 18 CarShare vehicles at UCSF.
- 450+ UCSF CarShare members & 100+ Departmental members.

Public Transit pass sales

- Two onsite Clipper Card sales locations processing 7,000+ annual Clipper sales transactions.

Pretax Programs

- Over 2,840 employees participate in the pretax transit programs. UCSF employees save over \$1.5M on public transit commute costs per year by participating in the pretax transit program.
- All employees who purchase campus parking permits are automatically enrolled in a parking pretax program, saving 30% on their monthly permit cost.

Vanpool

- 25+ vanpools traveling as far as Sacramento with partnership with Enterprise Rideshare.

Carpool Matching

- UCSF ride matching program with 630+ users across MyCommute, Scoop, Waze and Zimride platforms
- 70+ Reserved carpool stalls at the various campus sites

Emergency Ride Home Program

- \$50 reimbursement for emergency transportation home for employees who participate in a UCSF alternative transportation program.
